Chapter 1

- The three generally recognized sources of knowledge:
 1. Sense perception
 2. Intellect
 3. Revelation (*Wahi*)

- Holy Books/Scriptures mentioned in the Quran:
 1. Scriptures (*Suhuf*) revealed to Ibrahim (*'alayhi wa salaam*)
 2. Torah (*Tawrah*) revealed to Musa (*'alayhi wa salaam*)
 3. Psalms (*Zabur*) revealed to Daud (*'alayhi wa salaam*)
 4. Gospels (*Injil*) revealed to Isa (*'alayhi wa salaam*)
 5. *Quran* revealed to Muhammad (*sal Allahu 'alayhi wa sallam*)

- Muhammad (*sal Allahu 'alayhi wa sallam*) received the first revelation at the age of forty during his seclusion in the cave of *Hira*.

- The revelation continued over a period of 23 years.

- The revelations continued until just before the passing of Muhammad (*sal Allahu 'alayhi wa sallam*) in the tenth year after the Hijrah ~ 632 C.E.
