2. See only Allah’s pleasure.
3. Make *Wudu*, and sit in a clean place.
4. Maintain humility and respect
5. Always begging by *Istia’tha* followed by *Basmalah*.
6. Let no day pass without reading the Quran
7. Memorize as much as you can.
